Old clothes/ coverall- acrylic paint does not wash out!

Newsprint/plastic sheet to protect the table.

Small selection of acrylic tubes, whatever you already have.

If you need to buy, -Fewer, but of good quality are best. Price is a good indication of quality, or buy from an art shop. A beginners set is ideal, or a red, a yellow, a blue ,and a white ,will do for 1st lesson. Full advice given on course.

Brushes, (as before.) A few good quality brushes(beginners set) especially for acrylic.

1/2 " flat , 1/4" flat, small round, (for fine detail.) or whatever you already have.

Water pot - jam jar,

Disposable Paper palette.- (you can go to The Works for this) or an off white non porous surface.

Rags, paper towels,

Also useful ;cocktail stick, redundant credit- type card, palette knife, a variety of old worn out brushes.

A pad in which to work will be supplied to new students. Returners, please ask in advance if your old one is full.

Tea /coffee available.
